**Welcome to Crestwood Food Service!!****Parents/ Guardians:**

Welcome back to the NEW hybrid model of education at Crestwood School District. Crestwood Food Service looks forward to providing your children with the same healthy breakfast and lunches that our students are accustomed to.

Whether they are attending Crestwood Cyber Academy, In-Person or Virtual Learning modules, meals will be available for ALL students or children under the age of 18 daily, based on the school calendar. Meals will NOT be served on non-instructional days or days when the district closes.

Enclosed in this packet of information is everything you will need to know concerning Crestwood Food Service. Please keep in mind that our menus, schedules and distribution of meals may change without notice. We will make every attempt to notify parents/guardians of any possible changes.

GREAT NEWS!! During the 2020-21 school year, all students will be eligible to receive breakfast and lunch FREE of charge. The USDA has approved FREE meals for all students through June 30, 2021. Parents/Guardians do not need to do anything further to receive FREE meals.

Students attending IN PERSON will be able to get meals at their respective school cafeteria during scheduled breakfast and lunch times.

NEW FOR 2020-2021: Crestwood Food Service has changed the system used for online payments in the cafeteria. We no longer use www.myschoolbucks.com. The new site used for online payment & free/reduced meal applications is www.schoolcafe.com.

Parents/Guardians will need to register at www.schoolcafe.com if interested in making online payments. There is a fee for this optional service. You will need to have your student's Crestwood Student ID number to set up an account. If you do not know your student ID number, please contact your student's respective school office.

If you prefer to pay cash or check, please note that payment will only be accepted in the morning during the first full hour of classes. At our elementary schools, homeroom teachers will collect any payments and send to the cafeteria. At our secondary campus, students can make payments by dropping it off in the PAYMENT BOX located just inside the HS cafeteria.

No payments will be accepted in the cafeteria line during meal service. ALSO, change will not be provided at this time. Please be sure to have the exact amount you want deposited. Food Service staff will deposit the full amount given.

Please be sure all payments are secured in a plain envelope with the student name clearly printed on the front. All checks or money orders must be made payable to **CRESTWOOD CAFETRIA FUND.**

NEW FOR 2020-2021: ALL Crestwood students have been assigned a new 4-digit PIN. This number will be provided to students during the first week of classes. Students only need to use their cafeteria PIN for extra purchases like an extra entrée or beverage.

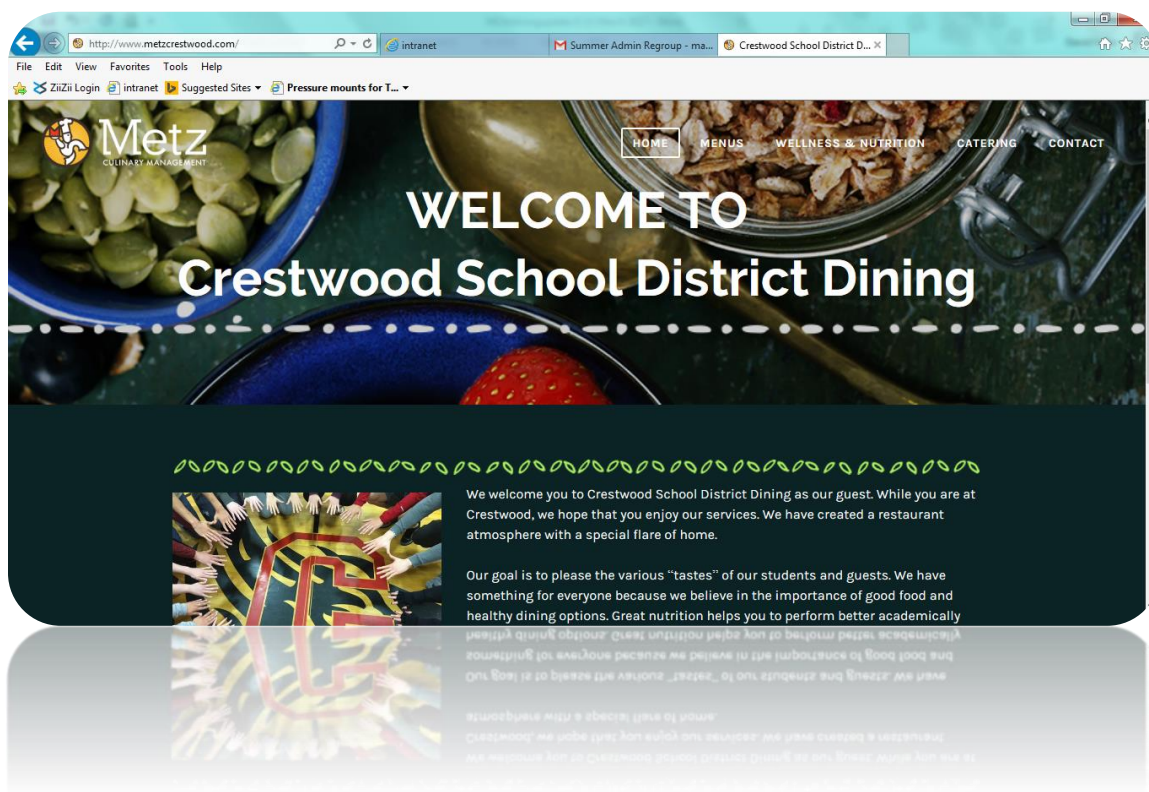
